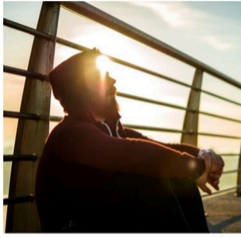


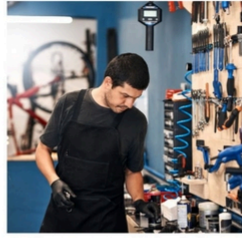

## Restore: April Was Reentry Month

Currently in the state of Ohio there are over 45,000 people incarcerated, most of which will return home at some point. We are thankful that [relink.org](#) is on all of their prison tablets as a resource to make a reentry plan. We participated in several events in April that help those returning

home, do so successfully. We wanted to highlight a few and thank those who put them together!

1. We participated in and sponsored several ODRC reentry simulations
